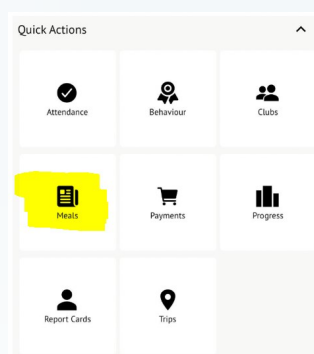

Water Bottles

It has been noted that there are a number of pupils who haven't got water bottles.
