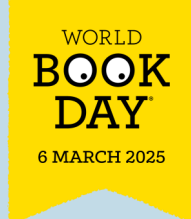

Celebrating Our Recent Teaching & Learning Review

On Wednesday, we welcomed Fran Ward, Trust Deputy Director for Teaching and Learning, for a Teaching, Learning, and Behaviour Review. These visits take place across all Rise schools throughout the year, providing both support and challenge to ensure the highest quality of education for our pupils and driving whole-school improvement.

We are delighted to share that it was a **very** positive visit! Fran was particularly impressed with the significant improvements in teaching and learning since the last review in October 2023. She highlighted the clear impact of professional development and training provided by the Trust—our pupils are now more engaged, and classrooms are calm, purposeful spaces where children are equipped with the tools and skills they need to succeed.

Additionally, she recognised the strong impact of our work on school values, Christian ethos, and behaviour—both in classrooms and on the playground. Of course, there is always room for growth, and one key area for further development is the presentation of work in books. We have taken this feedback on board and will begin addressing it immediately.

This successful outcome is a testament to the hard work and dedication of our staff and pupils over the past year. It also reflects one of the many benefits of being part of Rise Multi Academy Trust. Throughout the academic year, we receive a series of supportive yet rigorous reviews, each focusing on different aspects of school life, including Inclusion (SEND/Pupil Premium/EAL), Safeguarding, and EYFS. If you submitted a paper application and didn't include an email address, you'll receive your decision in the post. This can take up to five working days.
