#### English

**Key texts:**

**Writing:**

We will be focussing on writing to persuade and exploring a range of persuasive speeches before preparing to write our own.

**Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar:**

- Revision of Y4 punctuation
- Spelling words ending in -cious and -tious
- Spelling words homophones and near homophones
- Writing linking adverbs
- Writing adjective openers
- Identifying and writing modal verbs

#### Maths

**Place Value-** Numbers to 1,000,000, Powers of 10, Number line to 10,000,000, Compare and order numbers to 1,000,000, Round within 1,000,000.

**Addition and subtraction** – adding and subtracting numbers with more than 4 digits, inverse operations, multi-step calculations.

**Multiplication and division** – Multiples, factors, prime numbers, square numbers, cube numbers, multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1,000.
