Keeping Your Child Safe on YouTube

We know that many children enjoy watching YouTube, and when used safely and responsibly, it offers fantastic opportunities for learning, creativity, and entertainment. From educational videos to fun activities, there is a wealth of positive content available.

However, with so many videos and channels to choose from, it's important to ensure that your child is watching age-appropriate content and staying safe online.

Key Things to Be Aware Of:

- **Content Selection** – Not all videos on YouTube are suitable for children. Using YouTube Kids or enabling parental controls can help filter content.
- **Watching Time** – Encouraging healthy screen time habits is important to balance online and offline activities.
- **Online Interactions** – Some videos allow comments, which may not always be appropriate. Supervising what your child watches and engages with can help keep them safe.
- **Creating and Posting Content** – To set up a YouTube channel and post videos, users must be **13 years or older**. We are aware that some pupils are currently sharing their own content, which could put them at risk. Posting videos publicly means that anyone can view, comment, or share them.

How to Support Your Child's Safe YouTube Use:

- **Use YouTube Kids** – A safer alternative designed for younger viewers.
- **Enable Restricted Mode** – This filters out potentially inappropriate content.
- **Talk About Online Safety** – Encourage open conversations about what they watch and post.
- **Check Privacy Settings** – If your child is using YouTube, ensure privacy settings are on and personal information isn't shared.
