Relish School Meals – A Kind Reminder

Please could we kindly remind parents and carers that school meals should be ordered in advance, ideally with your child, and by the evening before at the latest. We are noticing a growing number of children arriving at school without a meal ordered, which makes it difficult to ensure every child receives the lunch they need.

Ordering in advance allows Karen, our wonderful kitchen manager, to prepare the correct number of meals each day and avoid unnecessary waste.

We also ask that you speak to your children about the meals you've selected together, as some children are asking to change their meal choices once they arrive at school. Unfortunately, we are unable to make changes in the system without parental consent.

Water Bottles – Reminder

Please can we kindly remind families that children should only have *water* in their water bottles during the school day. This helps us keep classrooms clean and free from sticky spills, and ensures that children can keep their bottles with them throughout the day.



If your child would like a soft drink (non-fizzy), they are very welcome to bring a low or no added sugar option to enjoy in the hall at lunchtime.

Please note that if we find juice in water bottles during the school day, we will kindly empty them and refill with water. Thank you for your understanding and continued support!



We've noticed that a number of items have gone missing from children's bags and from cloakrooms over the past few weeks, particularly in Years 3 and 5.

Please keep an eye out in case anything has come home with your child by mistake, and return any items that don't belong to you. We'd really appreciate your help with this.

As a general reminder, we ask that children don't bring personal items into school unless absolutely necessary. Things brought from home are done so at your own risk, and the school can't take responsibility if they go missing.
