Please complete the activities in **Red** and then try to complete at least three of three other activities:

<p><u>English</u> In English we are writing a writing dialogue. Write your own correctly punctuated short speech between yourself and another person. Remember to include reporting verbs that match the punctuation.</p>	<p><u>Reading</u> Children should read at least three times a week for 15-20 minutes. This doesn't always have to be the children's reading book from school. When reading with children concentrate on accuracy and checking their understanding of what they have read.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Practice times tables up to 12 x 12 until they are fluent. Log in to Times Table Rockstars for at least 30 minutes per week. Find every opportunity you can to practice.</p>
<p><u>History- Romans</u> Find out and write a fact file about Julius Caesar for our next half term topic.</p>	<p><u>Seasonal changes</u> Create a piece of artwork (in any medium) to show the show a fantastic winter scene.</p>	<p><u>School Values</u> This half-term's focus value is Perseverance. Write about a time you achieved something that required lots of perseverance to achieve. How did it make you feel when you were successful?</p>
<p><u>Science- Electricity</u> Create a poster, for children, about the dangers of electricity and how to avoid injury.</p>	<p><u>RE- Easter</u> Create a storybook / comic strip about the story of Easter.</p>	<p><u>Art – Still Life Drawing</u> Create a drawing, in pencil, of an object in your house. Remember to include shading.</p>
