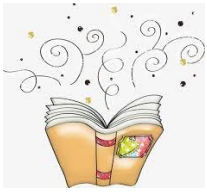


Year 1 COOL Activity Grid - Autumn 1

(Carrying On Our Learning)

Please complete the activities in **Red** and then try to complete at least three of the other activities.

Read and spell the list common exception words attached. After you can read and spell them use them in a range of silly sentences. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces, neat handwriting and full stops. Remember to practice and learn your weekly spellings too.	Read a book you have never read before.  <u>Challenge:</u> Tell us about your favourite part and why it was your favourite. You can write about it or create a picture poster telling us about it.	Find single digit numbers around your house and add 2 of them together. Choose which method you would like to use: - Tens frames and counters (see additional sheet) - Use your fingers by counting on from the biggest number. - Use 2 types of objects. <u>Challenge:</u> Write the 4 addition number sentences. $4 + 3 = 7$, $3 + 4 = 7$, $7 = 3 + 4$, $7 = 4 + 3$ Remember to practice Numbots aiming for around 15 minutes a week.
<u>Me and My Relationships</u> In PHSE our lessons are looking at our close relationships. Choose someone very special to you. Make a poster about why they are special to you. You could find out some facts about that person and add them to your poster.	<u>Phonics</u> Complete the weekly phonics sheets provided and upload them to Tapestry once completed.	<u>Science - Seasonal Changes</u> Go on a local area walk and take pictures of and collect things that you find on your walk that relate to the season of Autumn. Please see <u>Colour</u> grid activity.
<u>Colour</u> In Art we are exploring colour - including tinting and shading. With the objects you have collected from your seasonal walk, create a collage that celebrates the season of Autumn. Can you discuss which colours are Primary or Secondary colours?	<u>RE - How should we care for others and the world?</u> In RE we are thinking about why it is important to look after others and the world. Complete the sentences that are attached considering what it is that needs help.	<u>Geography - local places</u> Create a map, including a key, of the area local to your house. Ensure that the map is an aerial view.

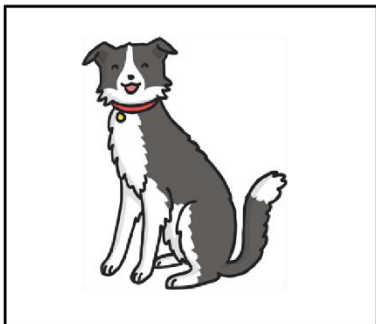

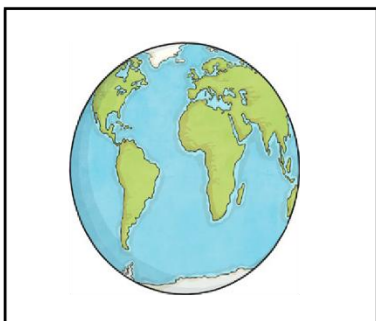
